

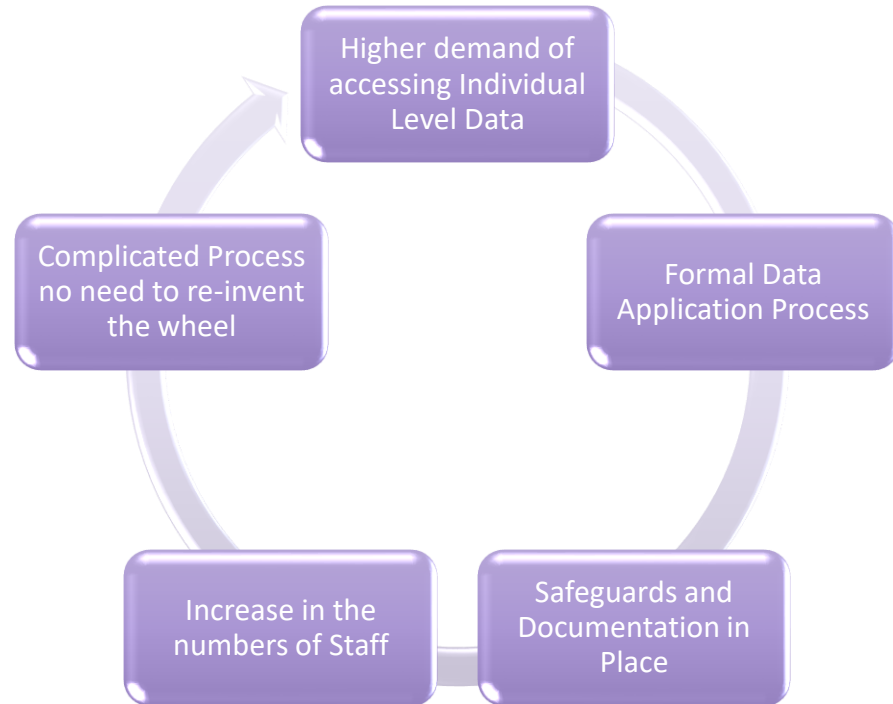

- **Privacy notice for children and young people:** UCL and Manchester Case Study

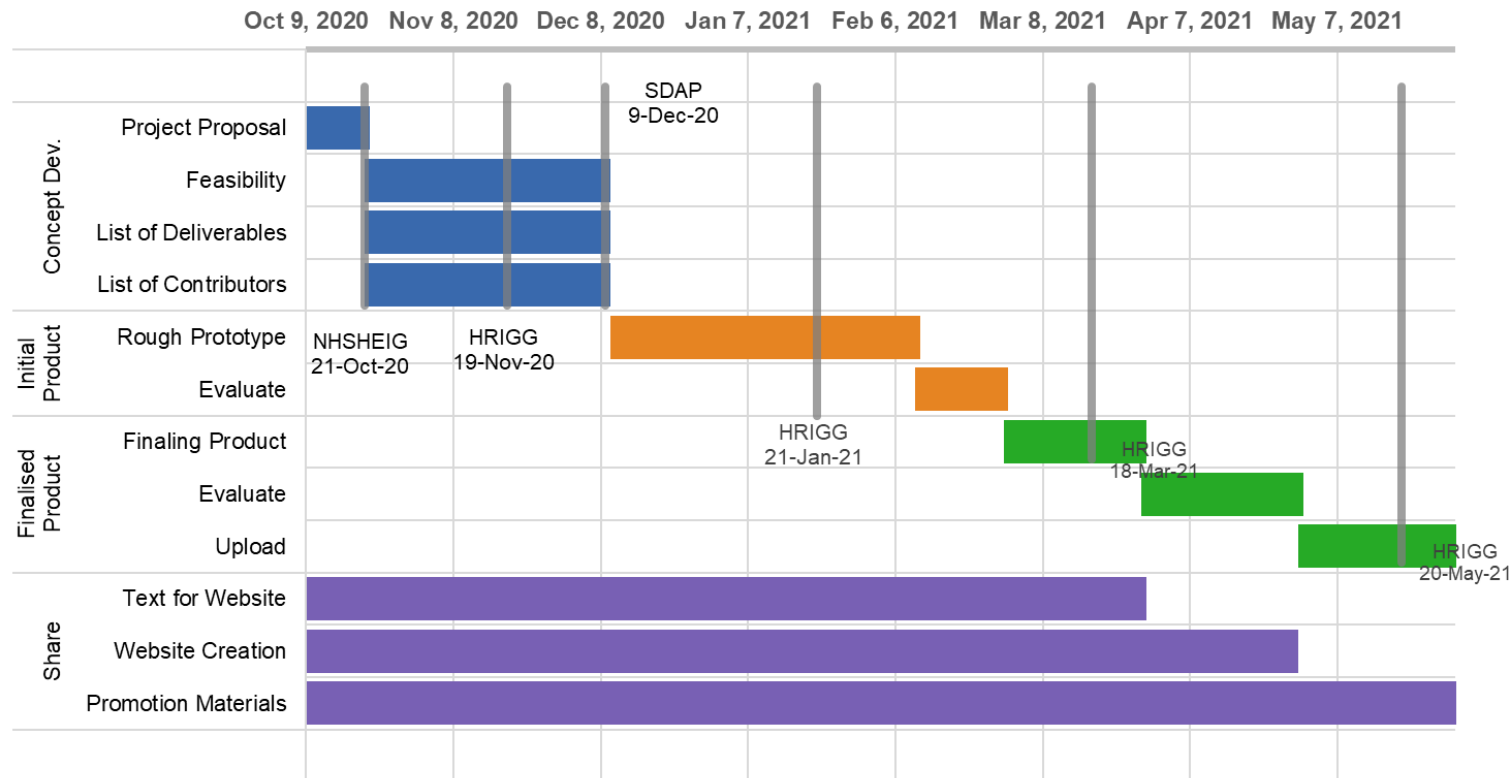
